COVID-19 Update

The WA State Government have recently extended mandatory vaccination in Group 1 to include 'Border and Air Transport'. This means that, Bunbury Aero Club staff are within this occupation group and are required to have a first dose of the Covid vaccination by the 1st December and be fully vaccinated by the 31st December. The current advice does not currently effect hiring members and patrons of the club; however, we will continue to monitor the situation and pass on any future requirements the WA State Government may introduce.

2022 Price Increase

As of 1st January 2022, the Bunbury Aero club will be introducing a 2.9% price increase across the board. This increase is to account for increasing fuel prices, wages and aviation insurance.

Annual membership fees, as discussed at the 2021 AGM in March, will also be increasing to \$162 per year - this equivalates to an extra \$1.00 per week.

CTAF Change

Bunbury CTAF will officially change to 127.0 on 2nd December. This has been an initiative by CASA, after public consultation, to relieve radio call congestion on 126.7.


Try setting a reminder in your phone to help you remember, or a note on the dash of your aircraft.

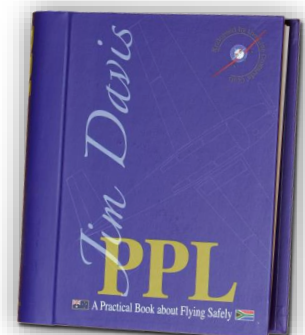

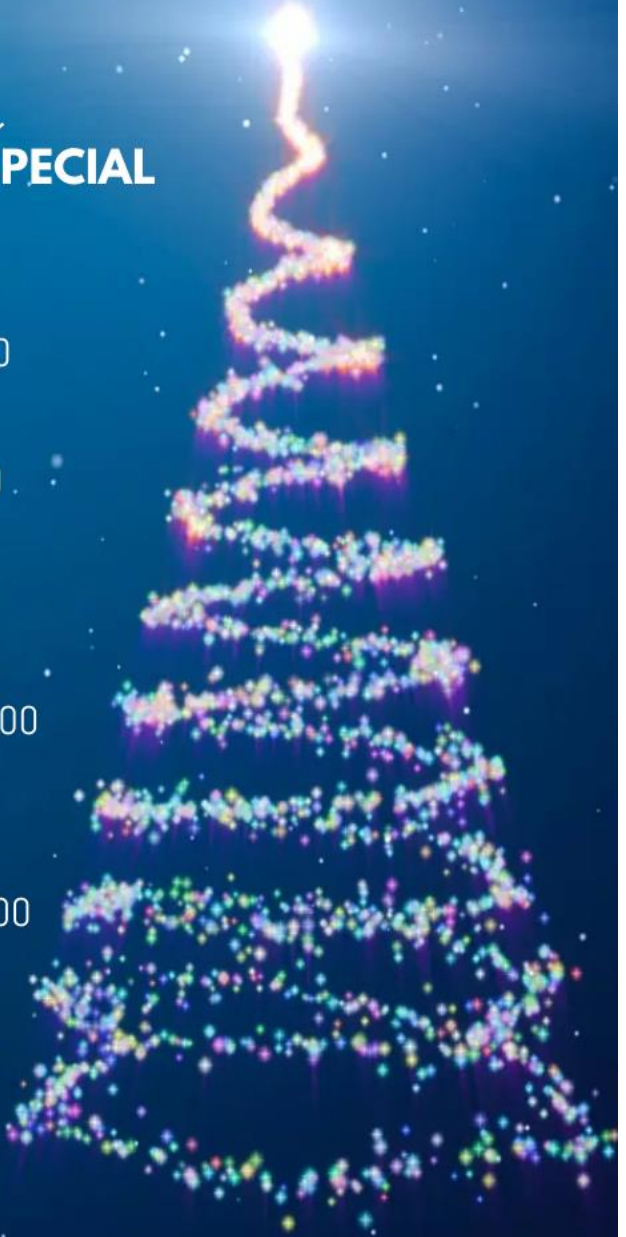
