
COVID-19 Update

Following the WA State Government mandate, when visiting the club everyone is required to wear a mask at all times inside the club until further notice.

Just a reminder that we offer two classes of members, other than a life member:

1. Ordinary Members

- a. Has all the rights provided to Members under the Rules, including full voting rights, and is eligible for nomination, election and appointment to the Management Committee as an Office Holder or ordinary Management Committee Member.
- b. with interests or objectives which include objectives consistent with the objects of the Bunbury Aero Club (i.e., a flying member)

2. Social Members

- a. Shall enjoy the same privileges and be subject to the same obligations as an Ordinary Member, except a Social Member is not entitled to:
 - i. be eligible to vote at any General Meeting;
 - ii. propose a resolution at a General Meeting;
 - iii. be nominated, elected, or appointed as a Management Committee Member; or
 - iv. nominate a Management Committee Member

If you know anyone that would be a valuable member to the committee, make sure you nominate them for one of the below positions!

- Club President 2-year term
- Club Treasurer 1-year term
- Club Secretary 2-year term
- Committee Person x3 2-year term

So we offer 'Right Seat' Courses for anyone who may fly with a family member or friend. You can complete it individually or get a group together!





Bunbury Runway Resealing

From *Monday 4th April 2022 until Friday 8th April 2022* the Bunbury Airport runway will be closed to undertake the works outlined below.

Monday 4th April

Runway 07/25 will be closed from 8:00am (a NOTAM will be issued 14 days in advance). Malatesta's will reseal the eastern half of the runway. JCW Electrics will dismantle the existing IWI and form and pour a concrete footing for the new IWI. City of Bunbury workers will replace the stormwater pipe crossing the runway.

Tuesday 5th April

Malatesta's will reseal the western half of the runway. JCW Electrics will commence installing the starter extension lighting.

Wednesday 6th April

Malatesta's will continue rolling the new runway seal. JCW Electrics will complete installing the starter extension lighting.

Thursday 7th April

Malatesta's will sweep the runway of loose blue metal aggregate.

Friday 8th April

JCW Electrics will install and connect the new IWI. BCE Surveying will mark the position of the runway line marking (AM). A line marking contractor will paint the new runway line marking (PM). City of Bunbury will undertake a safety inspection before the runway is declared operational (hopefully around 4:00pm).

Important Caveat

These works are weather dependent under which the City of Bunbury unfortunately has no control. Should rain occur during this period it may be necessary to delay or extend the period of runway closure. Updates will be sent out closer to the works period.

Impacts

Bunbury Aero Club and Bunbury Flying School - you will still be able to undertake groundbased training during the works period.

Rescue Helicopter Base - you will be able to operate as normal, however you need to be aware that under CASA regulations I will be de-activating the runway lighting to prevent aircraft inadvertently landing on the closed runway at night. This means the secondary IWI and helipad lighting will be non-operational.

RFDS, St John's Ambulance, Bunbury Hospital and SJOG Hospital - Any patient transfers during this period will need to occur using the RFDS helicopters. Aircraft transfers will need to be undertaken from an alternate airport (I'm assuming Busselton). As above, the runway lighting will be de-activated therefore the apron floodlight will be non-operational.

Water Bombers - you will need to relocate (I'm assuming to Collie) for the works period.

LAME and hangar owners - you will still be able to access your hangars during the works period via the two sliding gates however access to the front apron will be blocked to prevent clashes with contractors' vehicles. All the contractors undertaking works will gain access via the padlocked gate adjacent to the RFDS patient transfer building.

As of 8/02/2022, we please ask for at least 24 hours' notice to cancel or reschedule appointments. Failure to do so will result in a \$90.00 cancellation fee. This fee covers our time, wages and communication costs.

Please note this policy does not apply if weather does not permit your flight to go ahead, or due to extraordinary circumstances.

Our current scheduling system sends booking confirmation notifications by email 24 hours in advance to remind you of your booking. If you are not yet receiving these notifications, please let any of our staff know as they can sign you up.
